Samuel Magumba, a Global Methodist Pastor who serves the Greater Love Ministries in Jinja Uganda. He spoke about their proposed poultry project to provide jobs for their school graduates who don't go on to college to teach them a skill and also as a money making project for their ministry. The project includes the building of a barn, the purchase of chicks. a water well with four tanks and solar panels to minimize electrical costs, and a security fence for the six acre project. The total cost is estimated at \$95,000 in U.S.funds. Samuel visited six churches in our area and all of us are pooling our resources to help. Some of you have already given and we thank you for your participation. The Finance Committee made a proposal to the Operations Council that in order to be the hands and feet of Jesus Christ we should donate \$15,000 toward the project and that was accepted. We will be sending a check to Dublin First as the point for the project and they will be wiring the funds to Rev. Samuel. If you've not given to this project and would like to be involved you can write your check to the church and designate it "Uganda Mission."</div>
